

**ELK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

March 1, 2010**

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION/PRESENTATIONS/CORRESPONDENCE

PennDOT Correspondence dated 1/29/10 – Multi-Way Stop Installation and Speed Limit S.R. 3004 & S.R. 3002

Pal Durborow referred to Penn DOT correspondence dated January 20, 2010 advising that Penn DOT will install a stop sign on State Road at the Barren, Lombard and Blue Ball Road intersection, and will install additional speed limit signs on State Road and Chrome Road.

Southern Chester County Emergency Services Correspondence dated 2/20/10 – Dual Large Snowstorms

Pal Durborow referred to Southern Chester County Emergency Services correspondence dated February 20, 2010 stating that Medic 94 paramedics met the challenges of the storms, and thanked municipalities for keeping roads open.
